
Lake Central Girls, Michigan City Boys roll to victory at Post Tribune Event Dziezak (300), Schillaci (299), and Vild (298) highlight scoring

The Lake Central girls rolled to their second consecutive tournament title as they dismantled 15 other teams in the Northwest Indiana Post Tribune Preseason Bowl O Rama at Stardust Bowl in Merrillville. The defending state champions were never challenged and look poised to make yet another deep run into the state tournament. The talent laden senior lineup of Katie Sexton (429), Kelli Marx (417), and Kaity Galka (404) finished 2nd, 3rd, and 4th individually to lead the Indians. Joining the trio in the winner's circle were Ashleigh Wladyka and Alyssa Fortner. Portage's Megan Morris led all girls with her 432, while Griffith's Elizabeth Kras rounded out the top 5 with a 396. Falling to LC in the finals was a talented Highland quintet.

Scores were abundant on the boys side as three award scores were rolled as well as a impressive, if not record setting, team score, though, none of the above are on the resume of the tournament champion Michigan City Wolves. The Wolves defeated Hammond Morton in the finals which helped soothe some of their wounds suffered at last weeks Clay Invitational in South Bend. Coach Brian Schwanke's championship squad included son Taylor, Jacob Bowman, Kevin Pakuszewski, Jared Alsip, and Jacob Grams.

Lake Central's freshman phenom and 2009 Indiana Middle School Boys state champion, Nathan Maciejewski led the scoring barrage with a 518 two game set but it was Highland's Derrick Dziezak who stole the show. Dziezak rolled his first career 300 game enroute to a 512 series, good for third. Hammond Clark's Andrew Schillaci tossed a 299 in his 513 set that grabbed 2nd overall. The third award score, a 298, was rolled by Portage's Andrew Vild. Vild's near perfecto highlighted the Portage boys spectacular 1,358 total in game 2. Vild finished with a 511 set, good for fourth overall. Lake Central's Kevin Rush rounded out the top 5 with a 509.

In all 25 boys and 16 girls teams competed in the event held November 1st.




