NWIHSB Preseason Bowl-O-Rama Tournament Rules

- 1 Teams will bowl two regular games during qualifying. The top 16 boys and top 16 girls teams will advance to baker match-play competition.
- 2 Teams are allowed up to seven bowlers on their roster.
 Substitutions at any time during regular games and lineup changes are permitted at the beginning of any game.
 Changes during Baker game are NOT allowed.
- 3 There will be a five minute practice session prior to the first round baker matches.
- 4 Baker Match play will be the best 2 of 3 games format. The team that wins two games first will advance to the next round. Higher seed team will get to pick their starting lane.
- 5 Please turn scores in following each game during qualifying and after each baker match.
- 6 Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Team trophies for champions, individual medals for team 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Medals for top three individuals during qualifying segment will be presented during baker match play.
- 7 This event will allow the "developmental" (middle school) bowlers practicing with a high school squad to compete in the tournament in order to fill team spots allowing for as many IHSB bowlers the opportunity to compete.

 Teams can also mix schools to only fill extra teams (same sex except teams that are already mixed)
- 8 All USBC and IHSB rules, including <u>Varsity eligibility rules do apply</u>: except as noted. This is 1 of 3 NWIHS Tournament open to 7th & 8th Grades. This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 9 Cost \$40.00 per team for lineage

- 11 Schools will be allowed one boys and one girls team on a first come basis until the entry deadline date.

 After deadline date, multiple entries from the same school will be accepted.

NWIHSB Mixed Doubles

- 1 Event open to any IHSB bowler competing in one of the three (Quad County, Greater Lake County, or Lakeshore) conferences.
- 2 Two squads, limited to 64 Bowlers per squad, 3 regular games will be scheduled. The top 16 Boys & Girls bowlers over all will advance to the finals. Pinfall from qualifying squads will not carry over to finals.
- 3 Teams will be comprised of one boy and one girl. Pairings will be based on qualifying seed (#1 Boy paired with #1 girl, etc..)
- 4 Match Play to follow a 16 league schedule. Team's will draw for lanes, lane number equals team number, follow the schedule Match Play will be 5 games of baker match play.
 - 20 Bonus pins awarded for each game won.
 - Top four teams will advance to stepladder finals based on finals pinfall including bonus pins.
 - Stepladder matches will be one game, with higher seed choosing starting lane.
 - Entering teams will receive two shots on each lane (advancing team receives no practice but may practice on designated practice pair).
- Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches.
 Individual medals for top five teams. Smart Scholarships for top eight teams.
 Projected payout for 64 boys / 64 girls entries
 (1st \$300 / 2nd \$220 / 3rd \$180 / 4th \$140 / 5th \$120 / 6th \$100 / 7th \$80 / 8th \$60 per team)

HOLIDAY CLASSIC RULES

General Rules

- 1 Teams will bowl three regular games on same pair of lanes.
- 2 Teams are allowed up to seven bowlers on their roster.
- 3 Substitutions at any time during regular games and lineup changes are permitted at the beginning of any game.
- 4 Two divisions (Large School, Small School). This will be based on IHSAA classification for football (no football, use basketball). 5A and 4A (Large School), 1A, 2A, and 3A (small school)
- 5 Team trophies for overall champions (highest total all entries). Individual medals for teams finishing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each division. Individual medals for top 5 overall
- 6 Teams may be comprised of bowlers from multiple schools if necessary to fill teams day of event.
- 7 All USBC and IHSB rules, including <u>Varsity eligibility rules do apply</u>: except as noted. This is 1 of 3 NWIHS Tournament open to 8th Grades. This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 8 All Bowlers must be wearing their Teams Uniform
- 9 Cost \$40.00 per team for lineage and walk-in per team \$50.00 and the tour day of make up team is \$8.00 per bowler
- 10 This Tournament is an USBC Certified event.
- 11 Schools will be allowed one boys and one girls team on a first come basis until the entry deadline date.
 - After deadline date, multiple entries from the same school will be accepted.
 - Schools wishing to enter more than one boys or one girls team should notify tournament director at time of original entry submission.

NWIHSB Baker Tournament

- 1 Teams will bowl ten (10) Baker games during qualifying. The top 8 boys and top 8 girls teams will advance to baker match-play competition.
- 2 Teams are allowed up to seven bowlers on their roster. Teams will move one lane right each game.
- State Rule: In tournament play,
 Lineups may be changed at the start of any new game. A bowler may be used just once during any game.
 During the Baker games, substitutions at any time for the complete frame but bowler can't reenter game till start of next game Lineup change only at
- 4 There will be a five minute practice session prior to the first round baker matches. 2 ball's on there starting lanes in round 2 & 3.
- 5 Baker Match play will be the best of 3 of 5 first round and for the next two rounds the best 2 of 3 games format. Winner will advance to the next round. Higher seed team will get to pick their starting lane.
- 6 Please turn scores in following each game during qualifying and after each baker match.
- 7 Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Team trophies for champions, individual medals for team 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- 8 This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.

Junior Varsity Tournament Rules

- 1 Must be a member of one of the Northwest Indiana High School Bowling Conference and a USBC member.
- 2 This is 1 of 3 NWIHS Tournament open to 7th & 8th Grades.
- 3 To be eligible, Bowler must not have Bowled greater than 25% of varsity competition
- 4 Bowler will bowl (3) three regular games during qualifying. Lane movement in blocks for each game. The top 6 boys and top 6 girls bowlers will advance to stair step competition.
- 5 Please turn scores in following each Qualifying game.
- 6 Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Individual trophies for champions, individual medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- 7 This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 8 All USBC and IHSB rules do apply.
- 9 All Bowlers must be wearing their Teams Uniform
- 10 Cost \$8.00 per bowler for lineage
- 11 This Tournament is an USBC Certified event.

NWIHSB REGION RUMBLE RULES

- 1 This Tournament is an IHSB State Tournament warm-up. ALL IHSB rules, including Varsity eligibility, will apply.
- 2 Teams will bowl two regular games during qualifying moving 1 pair to right after first game.
 Teams will move one pair to right and begin a 5-game baker block. During Baker, teams will move one lane right each game.
- 3 Teams are allowed up to seven bowlers on their roster. Substitutions and lineup changes are permitted at the beginning of any game. Changes during a game are allowed per new state rule.
- 3a State Rule: In tournament play, coaches may substitute during the regular team games.

 Lineups may be changed at the start of any new game. A bowler may be used just once during any game.

 During the Baker games, substitutions at any time for the complete frame but bowler can't reenter game till start of next game.

 Lineup change only at start of game.
- 4 Top four teams will advance to stepladder finals. Higher seed teem will pick their starting lane. Stepladder matches are two baker game total pins.
- Teams in first stepladder match will be given two shots on each lane. Teams awaiting stepladder matches will be allowed to practice on designated practice pair once the second game of the stepladder match prior to their match begins. Entering teams will receive two shots on each lane (advancing team receives no practice but may practice on designated practice pair).
- 6 Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Team trophies for champions, individual team medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place. Individual medals for top 5 qualifiers.
- 7 Oil Pattern will be similar to the IHSB State pattern.
- 8 This Tournament is an USBC Certified event.
- 9 All USBC and IHSB rules, including <u>Varsity eligibility rules do apply</u>. No 8th Grades This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 10 All Bowlers must be wearing their Teams Uniform
- 11 Schools will be allowed one boys and one girls team on a first come basis until the entry deadline date.

 After deadline date, multiple entries from the same school will be accepted.

 Schools wishing to enter more than one boys or one girls team should notify tournament director at time of original entry submission.

- 2 To be eligible, Bowler must be Freshman or Sophomore No 7th & 8th Grades
- 3 Bowler will bowl (4) four regular games during qualifying. The top 8 boys and top 8 girls bowlers will advance to stair step competition.
- 4 Please turn scores in following each Qualifying game.
- Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Individual trophies for champions, individual medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Smart Scholarships for top five. Projected payout for 32 boys / 32 girls entries (1st \$75 / 2nd \$55 / 3rd \$45 / 4th \$35 / 5th \$30 per division)
- 6 This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 7 All USBC and IHSB rules do apply.
- 8 Cost \$15.00 per bowler \$8.00 for lineage and \$7.00 for awards
- 9 All Bowlers must be wearing their Teams Uniform
- 10 This Tournament is an USBC Certified event.

Appreciation Tourney Rules

- 1 Must be a member of one of the Northwest Indiana High School Bowling Conference and a USBC member.
- Entries limited to the first 80 bowlers. There are two divisions: Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch. Bowlers will bowl a 5-game qualifying block across 10 lanes
 Top 8 Advance to Bracket Round. Seeds #1 & #2 will receive two byes, Seeds #3 & #4 will receive one bye.
 (Round 1 #8vs#5, #6vs#7, Round 2 Winners Round 1 vs. #3 & #4, Round 3 Winners Round 2 vs. #1 & #2)
- 3 Please turn scores in following each Qualifying game.
- 4 Awards will be presented immediately following championship matches. Individual medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Smart Scholarships for top eight. Projected payout for 40 boys / 40 girls entries (1st \$225 / 2nd \$175 / 3rd & 4th \$125 / 5th & 6th \$100 / 7th & 8th \$50 per division)
- 5 This tournament is not an officially recognized event by IHSB.
- 6 All USBC and IHSB rules do apply. Any special circumstance will be decided by the tournament director.
- 7 Cost \$25.00 per bowler \$0.00 for lineage and \$25.00 for awards 100% of Entry Fee goes to Scholarship Fund All Lineage donated by Hobart Lanes
- 8 All Bowlers must be wearing their Teams Uniform
- 9 This Tournament is an USBC Certified event.

NWIHSB Rule Amendment

Middle School(7,8) that are practicing with the High School Team may bowl in any NWI Tournament with the expectation of the NWIHSB Mystery Doubles, Baker, Regional Rumble and Futures.

When mixing team preference should always go to High School bowlers before Middle school when forming a mix team in NWIHSB

Coaches shouldn't replace a High School bowler with an Middle School bowler if a High School bowler is available.
