- 1. This tournament is certified by the USBC and the ISUSBCYA and shall be governed by the rules of USBC. USBCYA rule 400 will apply.
- 2. This tournament is open to all 2013/2014 certified Indiana youth and adult bowlers.
- 3. This tournament will use the bowlers highest 2013-2014 certified season ending average for 15 games or more. Averages must be verified by a final league standing sheet at the time of bowling or as listed on Bowl.com. Failure to provide average verification will result in the bowler using a 220 average. Bowlers using an incorrect average will result in their score being disgualified and any winnings being forfeited.
  - a. Rule 319d and 319e will be waived.
- 4. Youth handicap will be based on 100% of 160 and 220 averages in their respective divisions. Adult handicap will be based on 100% of a 220 average.
- 5. There will be three (3) youth boys and three (3) youth girls divisions (scratch, 161 and over handicap, 160 and under handicap) and two (2) adult divisions (scratch and handicap).
- 6. ENTRY FEE must be sent with registration form. Pre-registration entries must be received by midnight, August 13, 2014. Entry fees are based on the following: \$10.00 lineage, \$1.00 for breast cancer research, \$1.00 administrative fee, cc processing fee (where applicable), and balance applied toward scholarship awards. Award fees returned 100%.
- 7. Walk-ins are welcome, space permitting. Bowlers wishing to bowl together must pre-register and all entries must be sent in at the same time. Bowlers who do not pre-register but wish to bowl together must check in at the same time no guarantees.
- 8. All bowlers will bowl four (4) games and throw out the lowest game; total pin series will determine the winner. Ties will be broken by the total four game series. If still tied, the highest game in the series will determine the winner.
- 9. This tournament follows a one (1) lane courtesy rule; anyone found to be in violation may have their scores disqualified. Please be ready to bowl when it is your turn to keep things moving along.
- 10. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. **Breast cancer awareness or pink attire is highly encouraged**. No clothing with offensive writing, alcohol or tobacco products.
- 11. This is a non-smoking tournament. No alcoholic beverages will be served to adult bowlers while bowling in this tournament.
- 12. Only bowlers and Tournament Officials shall be permitted in the settee area during competition.
- 13. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice on starting lanes before their squad starts.
- 14. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
- 15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than thirty (30) minutes after completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director within forty-eight (48) hours or before the awards are given out. Each protect under this rule must be specific in itself.
- 16. Scholarships will be given in all six youth divisions with a \$150 minimum guaranteed for 1<sup>st</sup> place in each division. Scholarships will be returned 100% to bowlers based on at least one (1) for ten (10) entries.
- 17. Scholarships will be administered by the ISUSBCYA with funds being sent to the Smart Program at the USBC National Office.
- 18. In consideration of ISUSBCYA, conducting the Tournament releases ISUSBCYA and USBC from any and all liability for any injury or accident involving entrant as a result of entrant participating therein.
- 19. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Tournament Director. Any further protest will be determined by the USBC Rules Department.
