Congratulations on qualifying to participate in the 2019 Indiana High School Bowling Regional Finals!

This event will take place on Saturday, January 19^{th} at City Lanes, 1901 South Woodland Ave, Michigan City 46360. The center's phone number is (219) 872-9930. At this time, singles check-in is scheduled to begin at 8:00 am followed by opening ceremonies at approximately 8:30 am. The bowling competition should begin at 9:00 am. Team check-in is scheduled from 11:30am – 12:30pm, with bowling competition scheduled to begin at 1:00 pm. (Local time – Central)

Indiana weather is always an issue in February. We will bowl at the scheduled time unless the travel in the host area is restricted. The host center will have the most accurate info. Remember, regardless of the conditions, it is your decision to travel or not.
