√ Sunday, October 10, 2021	12:00 PM	Plaza Lanes (Highland, IN)	IHSB Preseason Bowl-O-Rama	Format - 2 games regular team bowling. Top 16 teams will advance to bracketed match play (best 2 of 3 baker games). Schools may enter more than one team. Walk-ins will ONLY be accepted if lane availability.
√ Sunday, November 14, 2021	10:00 AM	Country Lanes (Lowell, IN)	NWIHSB Appreciation Tourney	Entries limited to the first 80 bowlers. There are two divisions: Boys Scratch, Girls Scratch. Bowlers will bowl a 5-game qualifying block across 10 lanes. The top 8 totals per division will advance to an eliminator final.
√ Saturday, December 4, 2021	12:00 PM	City Lanes (Michigan City, IN)	NWIHSB Region Rumble	Teams will bowl two regular games of bowling, followed by 5 games of baker. Field will be cut to top four teams who advance to bowl stepladder finals. Each match will be the two baker games, team with highest pinfall advances to next match. Two divisions (Varsity Boys, Varsity Girls,) Shot will be similar to IHSB Post Season Shot.
√ Saturday, December 18, 2021	12:00 PM	Plaza Lanes (Highland, IN)	NWIHSB Baker	Teams will bowl 12 games of baker. Top 4 Teams will advance to stepladder finals. All stepladder matches will be 2 baker games - highest total pinfall advances. Open 9-12 Graders
√ Monday, December 27, 2021	9:00 AM 12:00 PM 3:00 PM	Inmans Bowling & Recreation Center (Valparaiso, IN)	NWIHSB Mystery Doubles	Two squads, limited to 64 Bowlers per squad, 3 regular games. The top 16 Boys & Girls bowlers over all will advance to the finals. Pins will not carry over. Match Play will consist of 5 baker games plus bonus points. Top 4 teams will advance to stepladder finals (single baker game. House Shot will be used. Varsity eligibility rules do apply. No 6th, 7th & 8th Graders
√ Saturday, January 1, 2022	12:00 PM	Olympia Lanes (Hammond, IN)	NWIHSB Holiday Tournament	Teams will bowl three regular games of bowling. There will be two divisions (Large School & Small School) for boys and girls
√ Sunday, January 16, 2022	12:00 PM	Country Lanes (Lowell, IN)	NWIHSB JV Championship	Bowlers will bowl 3 games of qualifying. Moving one pair to right Top Six bowlers will advance to championship round. Championship Round will be head-head match play. Top two seeds during qualifying will get first round bye. Two Divisions: Boys, Girls.
√ Sunday, January 30, 2022	12:00 PM	Country Lanes (Lowell, IN)	NWIHSB All Conference	7 Bowler Roster from each of 3 NWI IHSB All-Conference Teams Boys & Girls 12 Games of baker. 'Bowled on 3 lanes moving right each game, High games each set get 2 point 2nd 1 point and 3rd zero points. 'Top two teams advance to finals based on points won.
√ Sunday, February 6, 2022	12:00 PM	Stardust II (Merrillville, IN)	NWIHSB Futures	Bowlers will bowl 4 games of qualifying. Top Eight bowlers will advance to championship round. Championship Round will be head-head match play. Top two seeds during qualifying will get first round bye. Open to 9 & 10 Graders Two Divisions: Boys, Girls.
√ Sunday, February 27, 2022	10:00 PM	Hobart Lanes (Hobart, IN)	NWIHSB Pro Shop Challenge	Two Divisions (Boys/Girls) Event is scratch. Bowlers bowl game 4 games across 8 lanes for qualifying. Top 33% of each division will advance to semi-finals, bowling 3 additional games. Top 4 after the 7 games advance to stepladder finals
